The joint MPH/MSW program requires its students to reach a total of 87 credits. These include 36 credits from the school of Public Health, 33 from the school of Social Work, and 18 field placement credits taken through the school of Social Work. Students are only able to graduate from the program once all requirements are met and the total number of credits reaches 87. Students must meet all requirements for both programs and graduate from both schools in the same semester.

\*The prerequisites for PUBHLT 2035 are; EPIDEM 2110, BIOST 2011 or 2041, PUBHLT 2015, EOH 2013, HPM 2001, PUBHLT 2033, and PUBHLT 2034. Students are able to register for PUBHLT 2035 and take one of the prerequisites concurrently with it, but all other classes must have been completed before registering for PUBHLT 2035.
