Dr. Newman is internationally renowned for her work in the epidemiology of aging, longevity, and disability, and has served as the principal investigator for several long-term studies of aging and longevity. Funded extensively by NIH and CDC grants and contracts, her research focuses on the epidemiology and implications of subclinical diseases in older adults, particularly on physical, cognitive, and muscle function.
