In his dual professorships and role as co-director of the Epidemiology Data Center, Dr. Belle's research focus is the design, coordination, and analysis of data from clinical trials and patient and procedure registries. He has served as biostatistician, co-investigator, or Data Coordinating Center PI for several observational studies and clinical trials in a wide variety of application areas, including hepatology (liver transplantation, hepatitis B, hepatitis C), gerontology (dementia, caregiving), and weight loss (bariatric surgery, behavioral intervention.)
