

Graduate Students & In Person Practice Experience during COVID-19 (updated 9/10/20)

Pitt Public Health practice experiences (e.g. internships, practicums and residencies) should be remote during all three of the University's [operational postures](#).

As outlined earlier in the Summer, exceptions can be made and those exceptions will require School level review and permission and must prioritize the safety of the student – that includes outlining details for how the student will be able to maintain physical distancing during the practice experience.

The school-level review process is conducted on a case by case basis and influenced by the University's operational risk posture (e.g. during High Risk few, if any, exemptions will be approved). Each exemption request will be reviewed by the committee established to review these cases.
