INTRODUCTION

REPORT OVERVIEW

Each fall the Pitt Public Health Office of Student Affairs conducts an online survey to assess post-graduation status and activities of recent graduates. This report details results from the 2019 and 2020 surveys administered to Pitt Public Health master’s and doctoral graduates from the 2018–19 academic year (**AY18–19 Grads**).*

This report represents graduates from the following disciplines:

- Behavioral and Community Health Sciences (BCHS)
- Biostatistics (BIOST)
- Environmental and Occupational Health (EOH)
- Epidemiology (EPID)
- Health Policy and Management (HPM)
- Human Genetics (HUGEN)
- Infectious Diseases and Microbiology (IDM)
- Multidisciplinary Master of Public Health (MULTI)

The purpose of this report is to provide insight into the variety of opportunities available to Pitt Public Health graduates. Survey data was supplemented with knowledge from departmental faculty and staff, as well as other sources of information such as LinkedIn, in an effort to achieve the most accurate and complete picture possible.

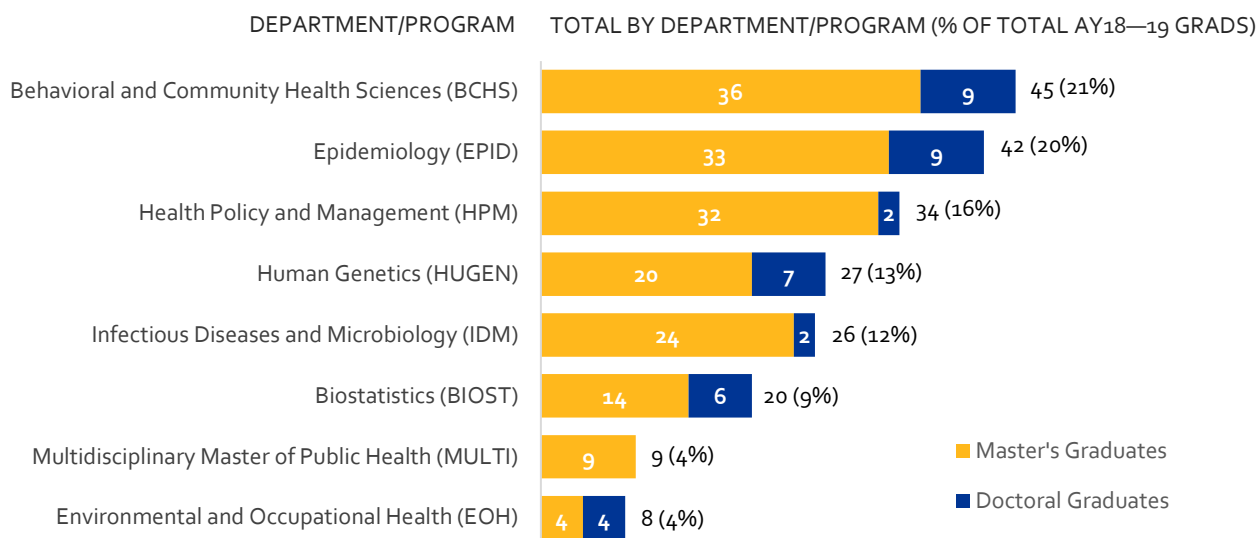

AY18–19 GRADS BY DEPARTMENT



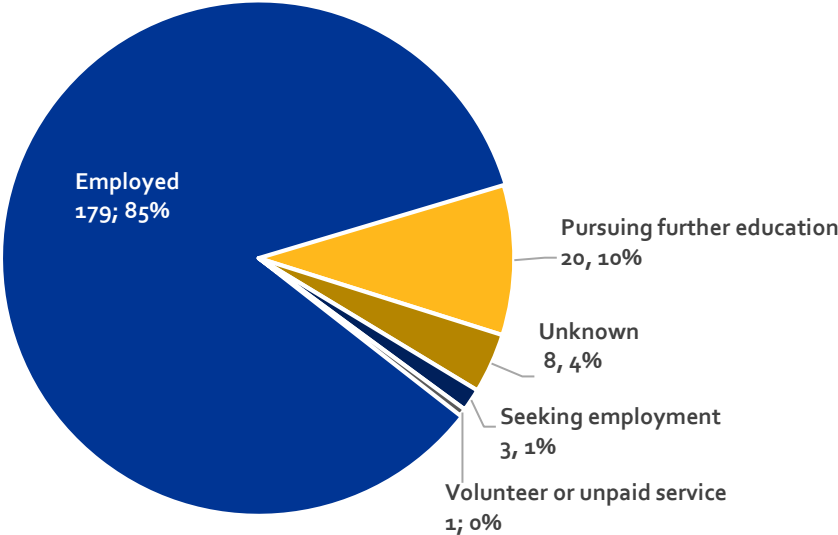

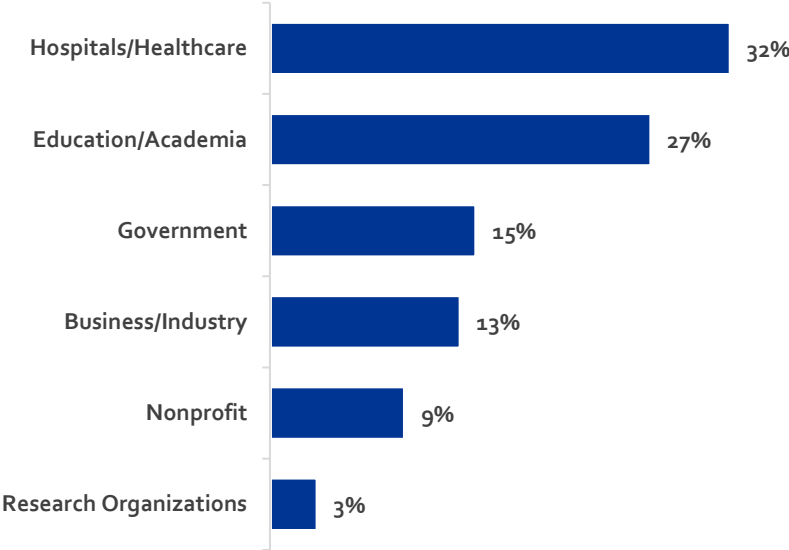

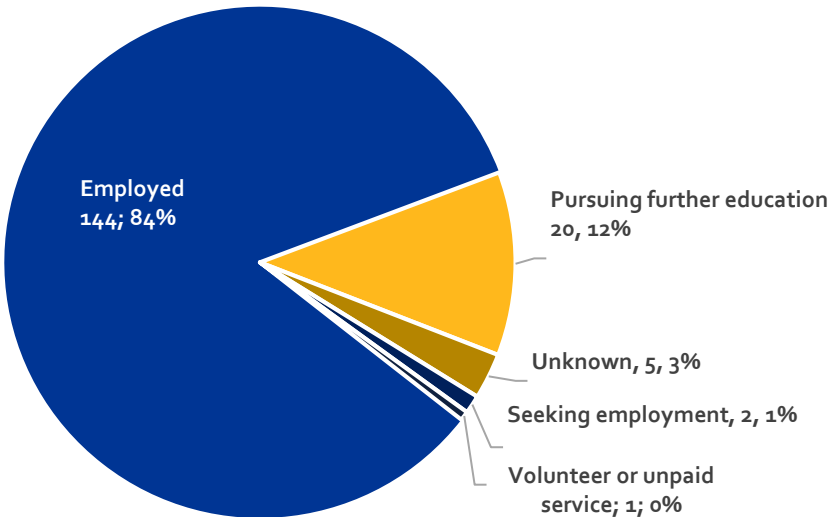
EMPLOYMENT SECTORS (BASED ON EMPLOYER)

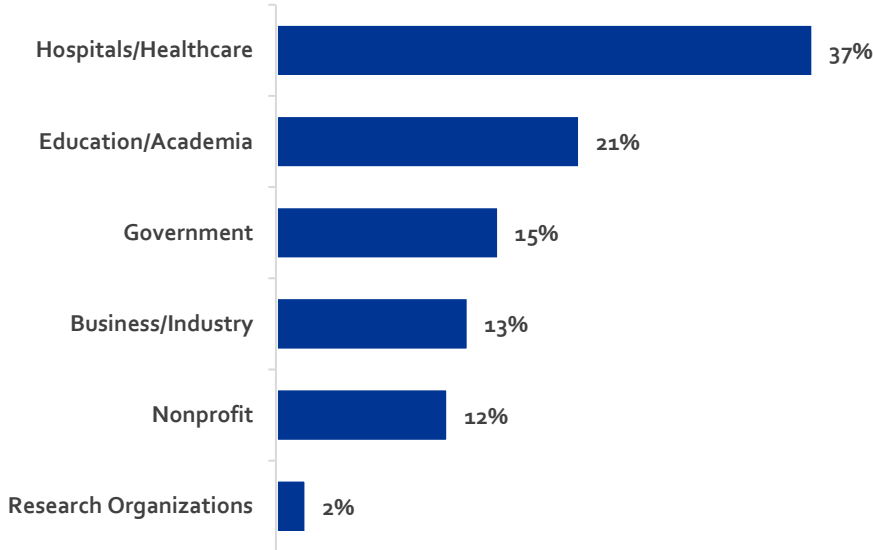

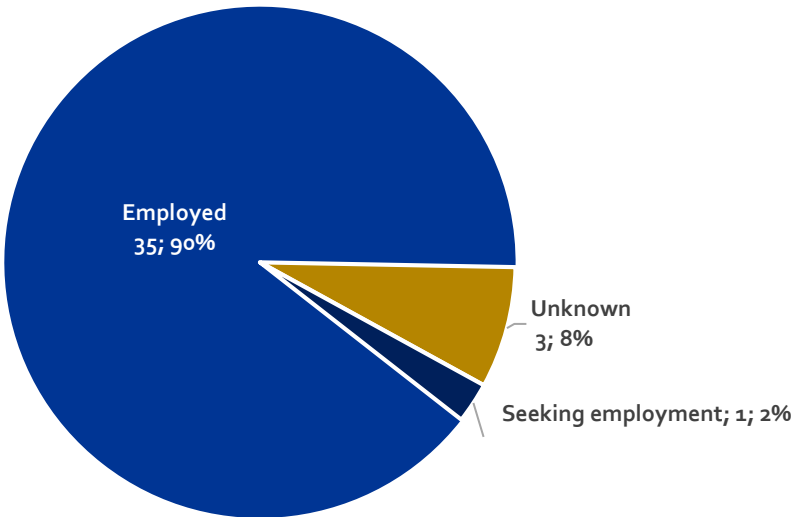
EMPLOYMENT SECTORS FOR MASTER'S DEGREE GRADS (BASED ON EMPLOYER)

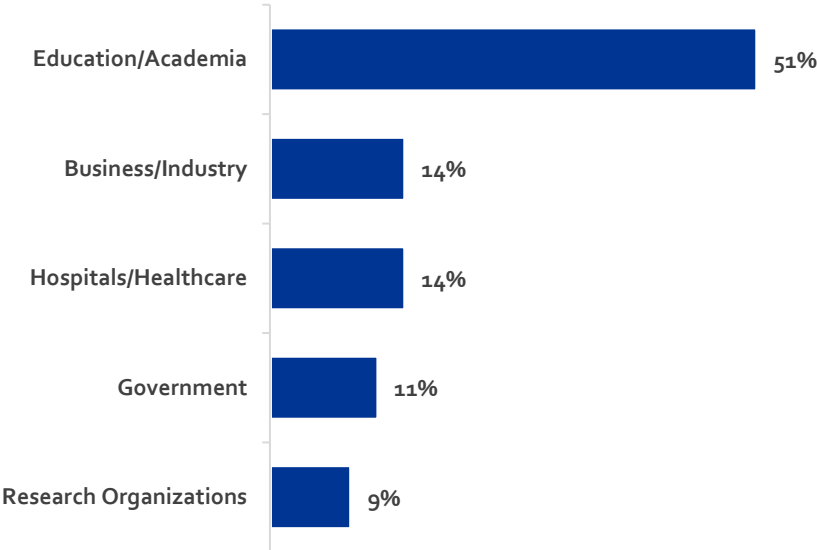

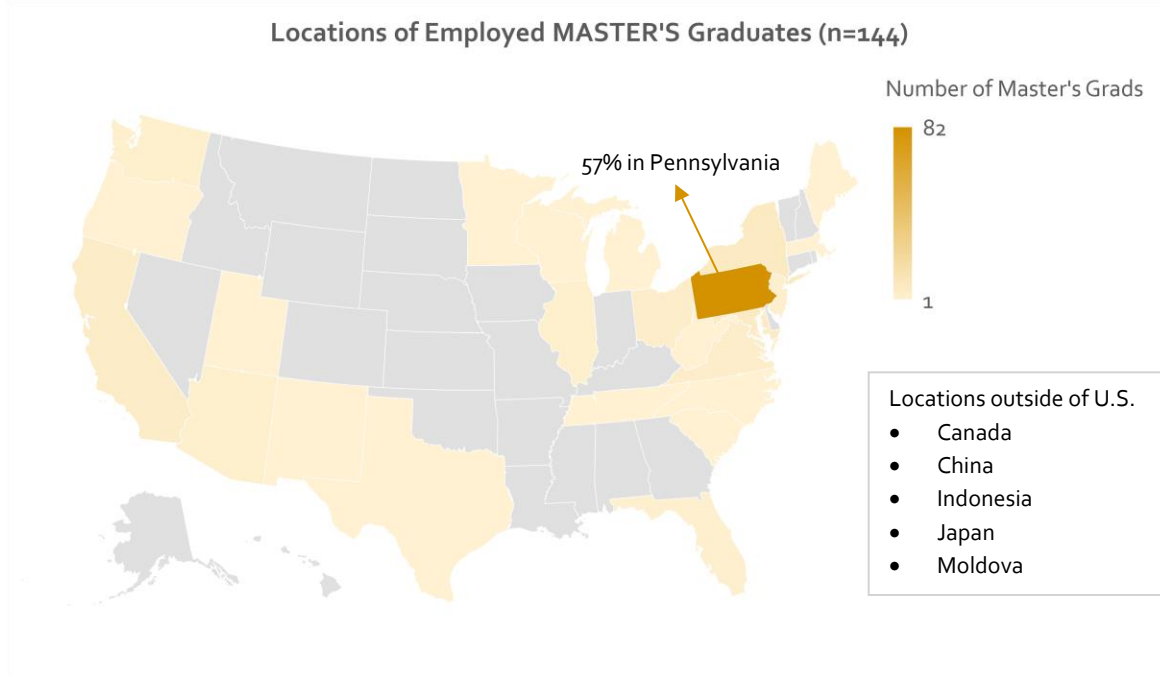
EMPLOYMENT SECTORS FOR DOCTORAL DEGREE GRADS (BASED ON EMPLOYER)



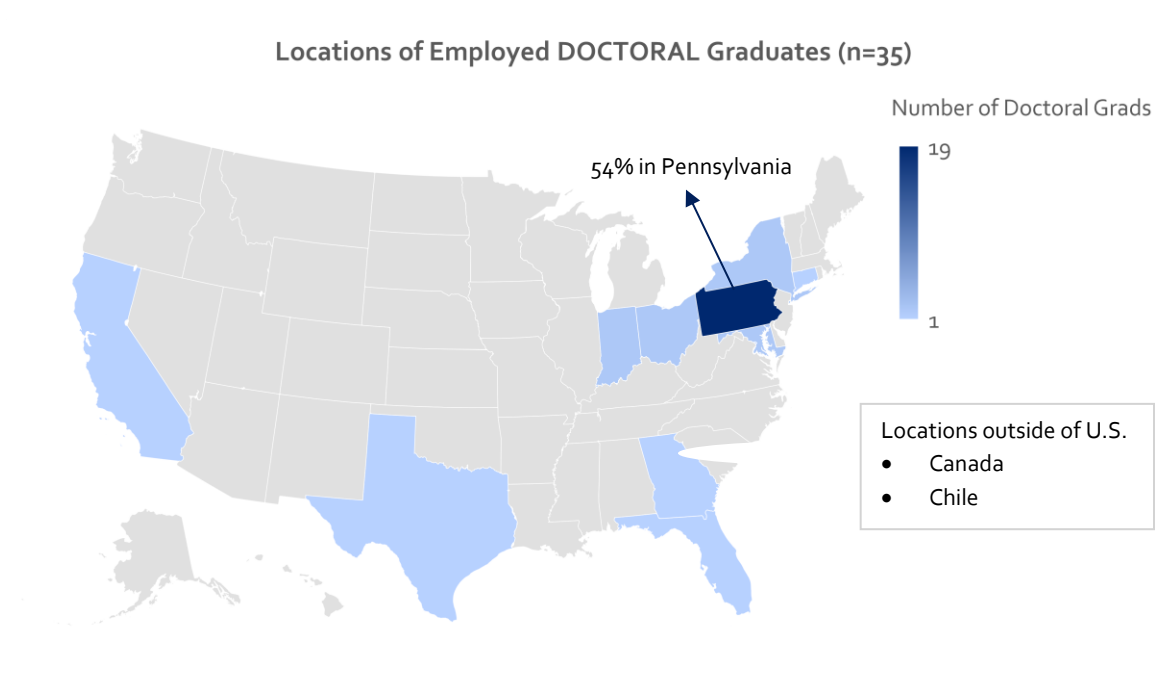

LOCATIONS OF EMPLOYED MASTER'S GRADUATES



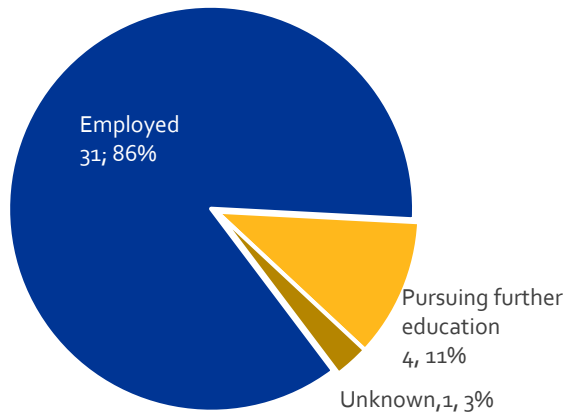
LOCATIONS OF EMPLOYED DOCTORAL GRADUATES

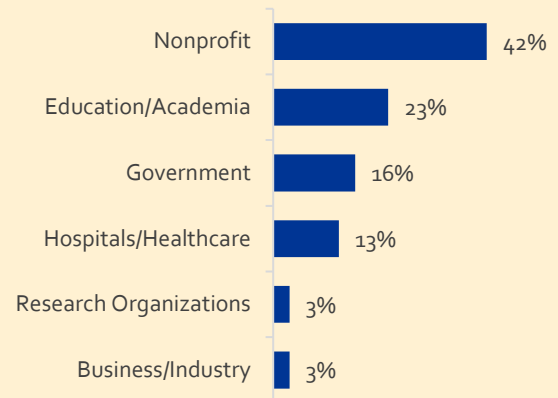

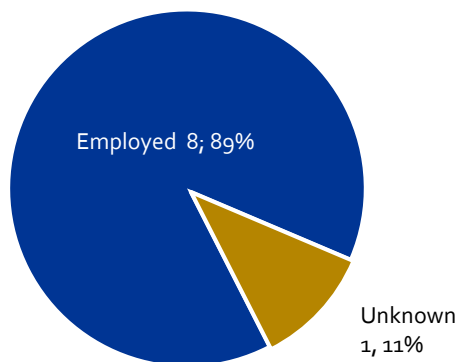

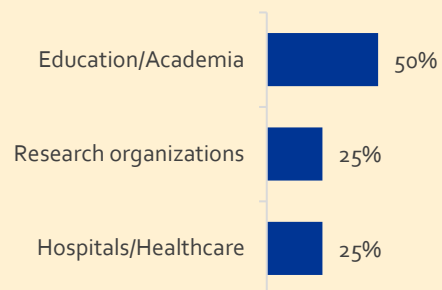

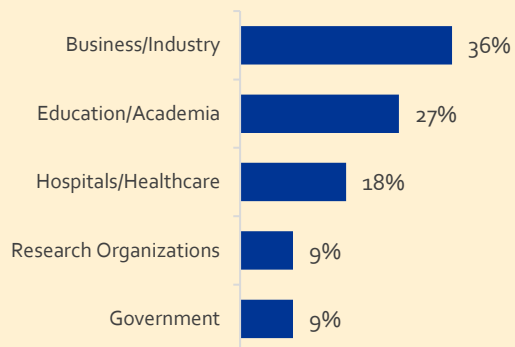

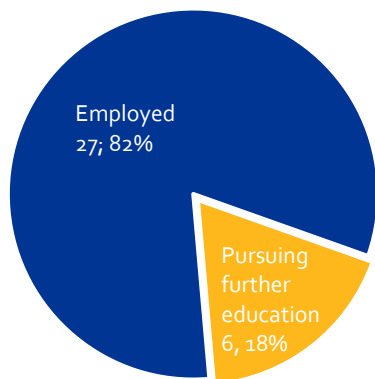

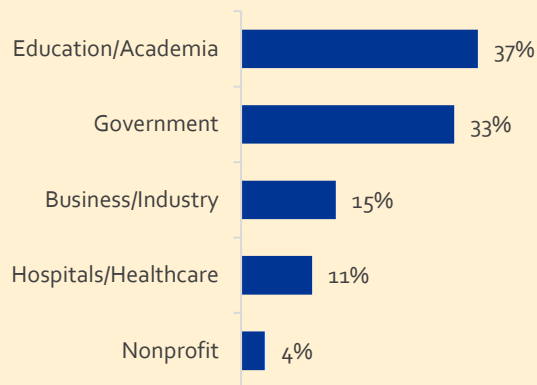

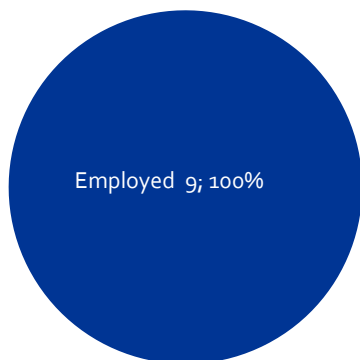

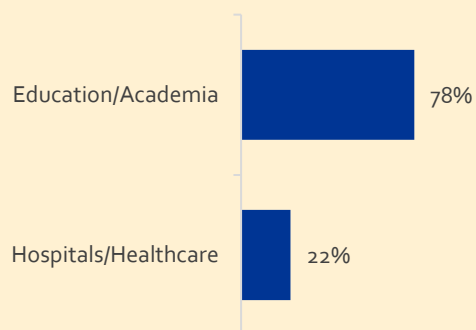

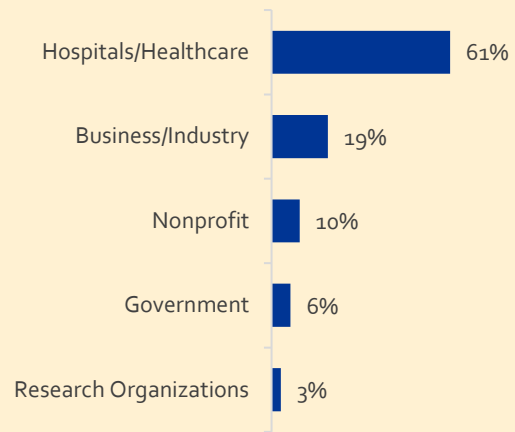

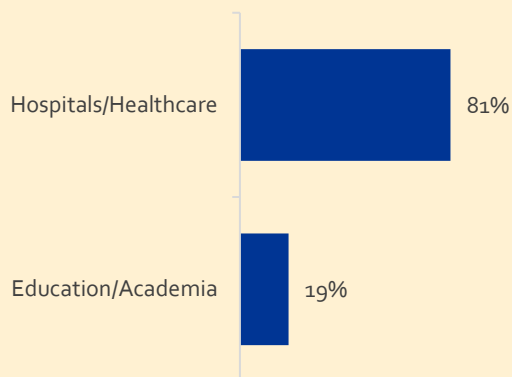

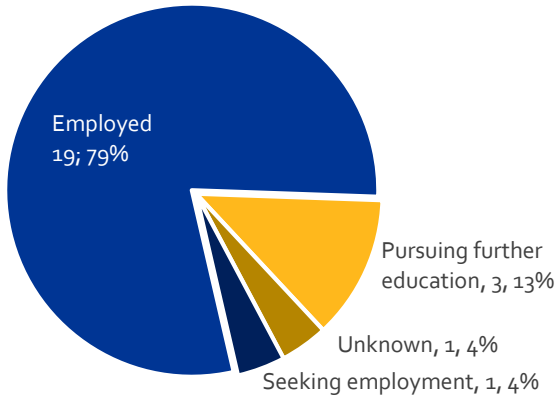

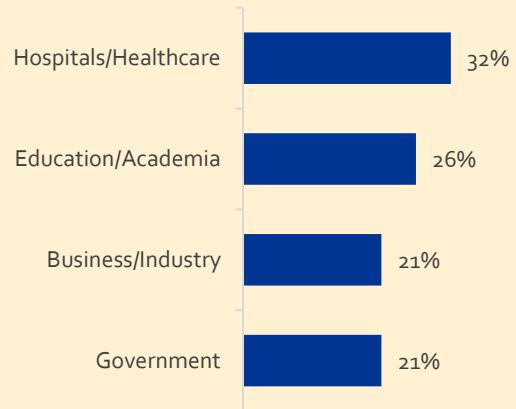

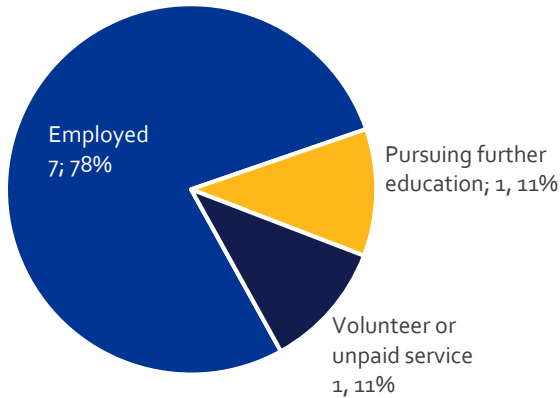

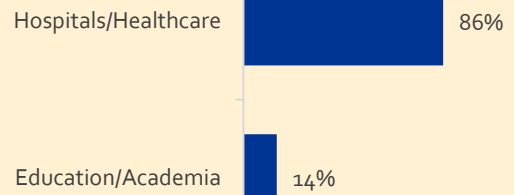
